The items include critical parts of x-ray machine digitizer, PPEs, Facemasks, protective gloves, sanitizers among many others. 9 rooms in their newly constructed trauma center were furnished by Mainstream for staff who work in the isolation center. These staff cannot return home to their families due to isolation requirements. A 350KVA generator was procured and installed to power the isolation center.
